2007 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon Coyote Vineyard



TASTING NOTES

Layered and lush aromatics of cherries and blueberries that have been dusted by cocoa. A hint of sweet lilacs join the symphony and graciously weave delicate notes onto the palate. Crescendos in the mouth with deep and brooding flavors of black cherries and berries. These components are decisively woven together in an elegant and velvet finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Coyote Vineyard has turned out to be one of our favorites for Cabernet Sauvignon. We harvested the vineyard on Halloween in 2007, at 27.2 brix. Using Rotary fermentation gives us rich, concentrated, luscious wine that is enhanced with oak aging. After completing malo-lactic fermentation in tank, the wine was aged for 26 months in French oak barrels of which 87% were new. The intense structure of coyote fruit allows for this amount of new oak. The wine was bottled in the Spring of 2010 and released in the Tasting Room in July 2010.
