Juicy, dark brooding aromatics jump out of the glass with blackberries, molasses and rich earth. These flavors expand on the palate with smooth and silky layers of chocolate, cherries and coffee. The flavors are dense and broad, filling your mouth with luscious layers that continue through a lingering finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

A few years back at Taste Washington we were stunned at the phenomenal quality of wine coming from Sheridan Vineyard. We relentlessly pursued getting some grapes from them, and finally in 2008 we were rewarded. The wine was harvested on October 24th at nearly perfect balance of brix, pH and acid. The wine was fermented using the pump under method and completed malolactic fermentation in new French Oak barrels. After aging for 34 months the wine was bottled in September 2011.
